A guest lecture was organized by PG Department of Geography and Environmental Sciences on dated 03 February 2020 in which Dr. Ranjit Singh Ghuman, Professor at the Centre for Research in Rural and Industrial Development (CRRID), Chandigarh and Professor of Economics at Guru Nanak Dev University, Amritsar was the Resource Person. He was welcomed by the principal of the college, Dr. Dharminder Singh Ubha. He proudly announced and informed the guest speaker that there has been no drug abuse case in the college till date. Dr. Ghuman presented his study on the drug addicting cases of North West India. He also further stated that out of all drug addicted people eighty four percent (84%) of persons falls in the category of the 14-20 years of age.
