1. Minutes of the meeting dated December 6<sup>th</sup>, 2017
  - Dr.Dharminder Singh Ubha, Principal, informed the members that the present strength of the students is 6635. He highlighted that the college won overall trophy in Zonal and Interzonal youth festival of Punjabi University, Patiala.
  - To provide alternate culture to the students and other stakeholders.
  - It was decided to celebrate International Mother Tongue Day.
  - To organize a two day Global Punjabi Conference. It was also decided that the event would be held annually.
  - It was decided to reconstitute the IQAC cell as per the guidance of UGC/ NAAC.

2. Minutes of the meeting dated April 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2018
  - Instructions were given to prepare feedback report by analysing the Feedback Performa filled by the students

  - It was also decided to make sub committees to fill different criteria of the reports.

### 3. Action Taken Report

- The College introduced a new courses of B.A. Honours in Social Science & Theatre studies as an elective subject.
- One Orientation Programme for the newly recruited academic staff and One induction programme for the students was organised by the Ganda Singh Career Guidance and Counseling Cell under the supervision of IQAC at the beginning of the academic session.

A total of 20 videos in the form of Shabads, Cultural Songs, Poems, Days celebrated, Short Punjabi Movies, Fest, Play, Conferences glimpse, poetic symposium, dialogue session have been uploaded for providing society value based entertainment.
