Web OPAC is linked to the college website to search college library records. It has been made so that any reader can search the library records sitting in any part

of the world and 4 touch screen computers have been installed in the library hall for the convenience of the readers. The college library is the first library to provide this facility. **RFID** (**Radio Frequency Identification**) is installed in the library. There is a comfortable AC hall facility for seating 200 students.
