On 18 March 2024, **Group Discussion activity** was organized to enhance speaking, thinking and listening skills of the students. A session was organized on the topic **Career Opportunities for IT students** on 19 March 2024.

An activity was organized for B.Voc. Food Processing and Engineering students to impart **skill based training** on **food processing and packaging** techniques on 20 March 2024.

On 21 March 2024, an interactive session was organized on the topic **Software Development: A Roadmap to Project Design.**

Mega Placement Drive was organized by Directorate of Education, Shiromani Gurdwara Parbandhak Committee, Sri Amritsar Sahib on 29 June 2024 in which 45 students of the college participated and **36 students** were selected. It is worth mentioning that during this drive, more than 20 famous companies visited Kalgidhar Niwas, Chandigarh, in which **Axis Bank, HDFC, Bajaj Insurance Company, Solitaire Infosys Limited, HDB Financial Sservices etc**. were included.

82. Publication Cell:

Under the supervision of **Dr. Pushpinder Kaur**, Dean, Press and Publication, **A Trilingual (Hindi, Sanskrit and Urdu) book named Guru Nanak Dev Ji Jeevan Aur Darshan** was published by the publication cell of the college during this session. The number of books published by the publication cell of the college has **increased to 32** so far. Among these books, **15 books are of Conference Proceedings**, **12 text books**, **03 literary** and **01 book related to** **college history** and **01 book to Sikh history**. Apart from this, the third edition of the textbook **Flame of Inspiration** was also published by this cell.

A sale counter was set up for the sale of books published by the Publication Cell of the college in the Book Fair and Sahitya Utsav-2024 organized by the Punjabi University Patiala from 30 January 2024 to 03 February 2024. On this occasion, students from different Departments of the college also participated.

83. Library:

During this session, 274 new books of Rs.76,113/- were purchased for the library. With this, the total number of books in the library became 51612. 5855 books were issued to college students, teaching and non-teaching staff. Under PTA fund of the college, 255 books worth Rs. 37, 470/- were issued for free to 84 meritorious and needy students of the college for the entire session. There are 74 journals and magazines related to different departments in the library. Currently, 20 newspapers in English, Hindi and Punjabi languages are coming to the library. Three e-resources N-List (5900/-), J-Gate (58366/-), Delnet (13570/-) are available in the college library. Through these e-resources, students and staff members can access a large number of e-journals and e- Books can be viewed online. Library is automated to perform library tasks in a better and faster way. College library records can be searched through OPAC and a web OPAC has been made, so that any reader can search the library records from any part of the world. 4 touch screen computers have been installed for the readers in the library hall. The college library is the first library where such facilities are provided. **RFID** (Radio Frequency **Identification**) has been installed in the library to avoid any kind of theft. There is a facility of a comfortable AC hall for 200 readers.

84. College Magazine 'Naviyaan Paidaan':

Under the careful supervision of Chief Editor **Dr. Harvinder Kaur**, the college magazine of the year 2023 was published to raise the hidden literary talent of the students and to provide them with information about the activities and achievements of the college.
