B.Sc. Biotechnology has been introduced in the college from the session 2004-05. This course is recognised by Punjabi University, Patiala. This college is the first college in Patiala to introduce it and second college in Punjabi University where this course is being taught. Forty students got admission in the first year of Biotechnology. Rs. 2,85,000 have been spent for its laboratory and college gained income of Rs. 10,00,000 from this course.

College hosted third Khalsai Sports Meet on 21<sup>st</sup>-23<sup>rd</sup> November, 2004.

21 colleges which run under the management of S.G.P.C. Amritsar, took part in this meet. A total of 1100 students participated. S.G.P.C. granted Rs. 15 lakhs to hold this meet. Nine new playgrounds of Basketball, Volleyball, Handball, Kho-Kho, Kabaddi National Style and Kabaddi Punjabi Style were prepared. The department of Physical Education gave a beautiful shape to Table Tennis and Weight Room. The students of Khalsa College brought laurels to college by winning overall trophy for the third time in a row.
