ACTION TAKEN REPORT ON (AUGUST 09, 2024) THE MEETING OF MAY 09, 2024

- 1. All the decisions taken by IQAC meeting held on May 09, 2024 under the Chairmanship of the College Principal were approved.
- 2. New education policy has been successfully implemented in all first year UG Programs except Bachelor of Vocational Courses and B.Sc. Agriculture.
- 3. New framework for Curriculum Design and required revision has been done according to NEP.
- 4. A committee was formed to assess the availability of physical and digital infrastructure for the students under NEP. The committee found that the college has adequate physical and digital infrastructure to impart education as per NEP.
- 5. Following reforms were undertaken in examination patterns and evaluation criteria:
 - Subjects in syllabus of multi-disciplinary courses and single major course will be categorised as Major subject, Minor subject, IDC/MDC, SEC, AEC and VAC etc.
 - ii. The examination duration of all 2 credit papers will be of 1.30 hrs and the paper with more than 2 credits will be of 3 hrs.
 - iii. All skill enhancement courses will be internally evaluated as workshops.
 - iv. DMC will clearly show the subject category as Major, Minor, IDC/MDC, SEC, AEC and VAC disciplines.
 - v. VAC courses will be of 2 credits each. In Sem-I VAC will be Environment & Road Safety Awareness and in Sem-II VAC will be Drug Abuse.
- 6. A counselling committee guided 3497 students about various programmes under the New Education Policy.
