## DETAILS OF VARIOUS STUDENT WELFARE SCHEMES

### SCHOLARSHIPS BY THE COLLEGE

- Students who have secured more than 95% marks in the previous class are recommended to be charged only University fee in the first year while enrolling in Professional Courses and for DPI Courses, it is recommended to be charged University as well as DPI fees. Scholarships awarded to these students in the following years depend on the marks obtained by them in their respective courses.
- Students who have attained 90% to 95% marks in the previous class at the time of admission are recommended a fee waiver of Rs.5000/- in the first semester and Rs.3000 / - in the second semester. Scholarships awarded to these students in the following years will depend on the marks obtained by them in their respective courses.
- Students whose parents are working in the institutions under SGPC administration are recommended the waiver of fee according to the following structure:
- 25% fee waiver for children of Class IV employees, 20% fee waiver for children of Class III and other non-teaching staff members and 10% fee waiver for children of teaching staff members
- Students belonging to economically weaker families or being particular cases of financial assistance are recommended a fee waiver on the basis of the student's performance in academic or any other field.
- Meritorious students of the college, who secure 80% and above marks are given free books from the college library for the whole semester.
- The college has established a Goodwill Cell to help the needy and meritorious students. The college staff contributes to this cell voluntarily. Besides, most of the faculty members from various departments are always keen to help the students of their departments financially as well as morally.

### CULTURAL SCHOLARSHIPS

The students getting first or second positions at the zonal level in the cultural activities may be granted the waiver of the student fund and students attaining first or second position at the inter-

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zonal level may be granted the waiver of the management fund also. Students who rank first or second at the national level are recommended the waiver of complete fees.

### SPORTS SCHOLARSHIPS

Students with national level performance in the field of Sports, or who are part of the University's Sports Wing, are recommended the waiver of their complete fees as per the University rules.

## AMRITDHARI SCHOLARSHIP

Students who belong to Sikh community and are baptized are eligible to apply for this scholarship

**Introduction:** This Scheme is available to Amritdhari Students who are studying under the various institutions run by Shiromani Gurdwara Parbandhak Committee, Sri Amritsar Sahib (An apex body of the Sikhs).

**Eligibility:** Student must be an Amritdhari Sikh (Baptized).

**Funding Agency:** Shiromani Gurdwara Parbandhak Committee Sri Amritsar Sahib

## SCHOLARSHIPS FUNDED BY STATE/CENTRAL GOVT.

### SC/ST/OBC SCHOLARSHIPS

Students who belong to SC, ST or any Unscheduled Caste are recommended to be charged a fee as per government rules.

#### Post Matric Scholarship Scheme for SC and BC Students

**Introduction:** The objective of the scheme is to appreciably increase the Gross Enrolment Ratio of SC and BC students in higher education with a focus on those from the poorest households, by providing financial assistance at post-matriculation or post-secondary stage to enable them to complete their education.

**Eligibility:** The student must be a Punjab resident and if he/she belongs to SC category, then the annual income of parents/guardians from all sources should not exceed Rs.2.5lakh and for BC/OBC Students the income limit should not exceed 1 lakh.

**Funding Agency:** Department of Welfare, Government of Punjab.

## MINORITY SCHOLARSHIPS

### Post Matric and Merit cum Means based Scholarship Scheme for Minorities

**Introduction:** Muslims, Sikhs, Christians, Buddhists, Jain and Zoroastrians (Parsis) have been notified as minority communities under Section 2 (c) of the National Commission for Minorities Act, 1992. A total of five (05) lakh scholarships are targeted to be distributed as 'Fresh' Scholarships, besides the Renewal scholarships. The distribution of scholarship among the States/Union Territories will be made on the basis of population of minorities in the States/Union Territories as per Census 2001 for 2017-18 and as per the population of minorities in the States/Union Territories of Census 2011 for 2018-19 and 2019-20 (as per Appendices- A & B).

**Eligibility:** Scholarship will be awarded to the students who have secured not less than 50% marks or equivalent grade in the previous final examination and the annual income of whose parents/guardians from all sources does not exceed Rs.2.00 lakh (**2.5lakh for merit cum means based**).

**Funding Agency:** Ministry of Minority Affairs

## **SCHOLARSHIP FOR MERITORIOUS STUDENTS**

**Introduction:** Scholarships to provide financial assistance to meritorious students from low income families to meet a part of their day-to-day expenses while pursuing higher studies exist as under:

**Eligibility:** Students who are above 80th percentile of successful candidates in the relevant stream from the respective Board of Examination in Class XII of 10+2 pattern or equivalent and are pursuing regular courses (not correspondence or distance mode) in Colleges/Institutions recognized by All India Council of Technical Education, UGC Act, 1956, Medical Council of India, Dental Council of India and respective regulatory authorities and not availing benefit of any other scholarship scheme including State run scholarship schemes/Fee waiver and reimbursement scheme are eligible under this scheme. However, students pursuing Diploma courses are not eligible under the scheme.

The parental/family income ceiling is Rs. 8 lakh per annum for all categories under this scheme and it would be applicable from the Academic Session 2018-19. Income certificate would be required for the fresh applicants only.

## PRIME MINISTER SPECIAL SCHOLARSHIP SCHEME FOR J & K STUDENTS

Students who belong to Jammu and Kashmir are recommended to be charged only University fees, Security and Parking fees.

**Introduction:** The Scheme aims to build the capacities of the youths of J&K and Ladakh by Educating, Enabling and Empowering them to compete in the normal course. Under the Scheme, the youths of J&K and Ladakh are supported by way of scholarship in two parts, namely the academic fee & maintenance allowance. The academic fee is paid to the institution where the student is provided admission after on-line counseling process conducted by the AICTE. The academic fee covers tuition fee and other components as per the ceiling fixed for various professional, medical and other under-graduate courses. In order to meet expenditure towards hostel accommodation, mess expenses, books & stationery etc., a fixed amount of Rs.1.00 Lakh is provided to the beneficiary and is paid in installments @ Rs. 10,000/- per month directly into the student's account.
